Tiley Roofing ([www.tileyroofing.com](http://www.tileyroofing.com)) is located in Arvada, CO and has been installing high-end quality roofs since 1996. We specialize in tile, slate, and metal roofing systems but we also do flat roofing as well as composition shingles.

We have been using TITANIUM-UDL synthetic roofing underlayment and our crews love it. The product can be left exposed without any blow off, tear off, or UV damage. We have had jobs exposed for over 1 month without any effects to the underlayment. Typically, with 30# felt, we would have had blow offs and call backs, which costs me time and money.

Our crews also comment on the excellent walkability of TITANIUM-UDL, even on pitches of 10:12. We would not be safe walking on felt on this pitch, especially in hot temperatures as felt becomes very slick due to the surface oils bleeding. We also noticed how much cooler the product was to work with because of the gray color compared to black felt.

The 10 square roll is also much faster to install, especially on larger roofs.

TITANIUM-UDL is a wonderful product. Tiley Roofing will continue to use TITANIUM-UDL as a replacement for asphalt felt underlayment.
