**Re: TITANIUM-UDL**

Dear Sir,

We install asphalt shingles, shakes, wood shingles, BUR, and Modified roofs. We have used 15 # asphalt felt, 30 # asphalt felt, and other synthetic underlayments underneath our roofing projects.

I am very impressed with TITANIUM-UDL because it:

1. Remains cool to the touch even in 100° heat
2. Provides better footing than asphalt felts
3. It doesn't melt in the heat like asphalt, especially on steep roofs in 100° + heat
4. It doesn't blow off in the wind. We had 95 mph winds and didn't lose any of the TITANIUM-UDL that was covering a new-housing development we were working on.

We are very happy with TITANIUM-UDL and we will not use anything else.

I have been roofing on and off since 1972 and have been roofing continually for the last 15 years. My son and I started our company 8 years ago. We worked a local hailstorm in 1999 and had over 300 roofs to do and we haven't slowed down since. I wish your product would have been available in 1999, as the quality and price of asphalt felts leave a lot to be desired.
